But as it exists in our flag too it represents love joy wisdom peace and hope

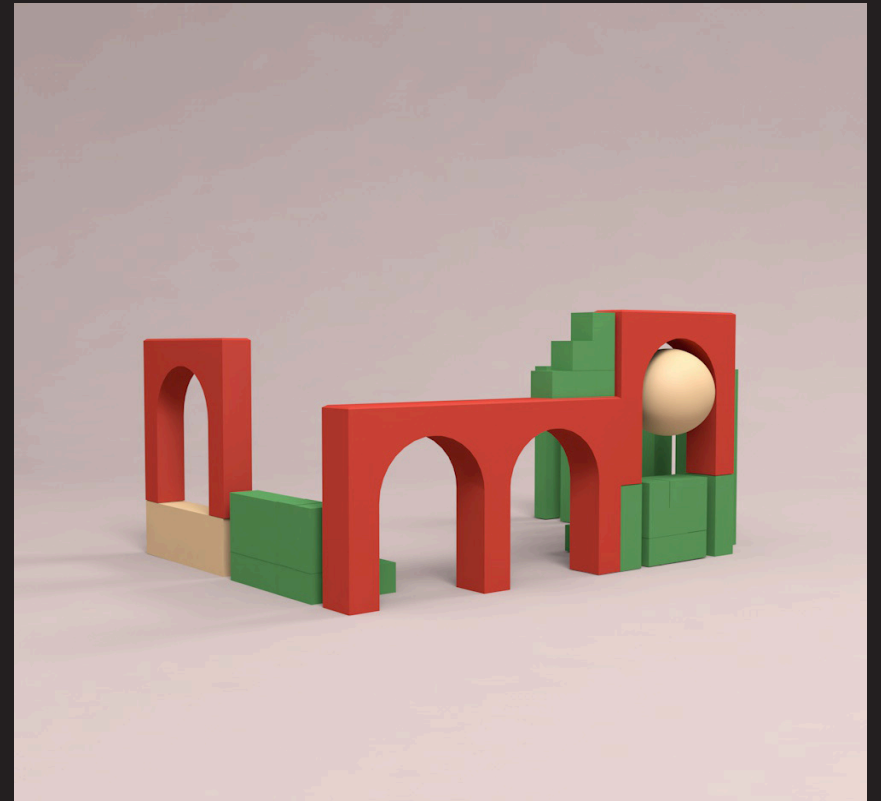
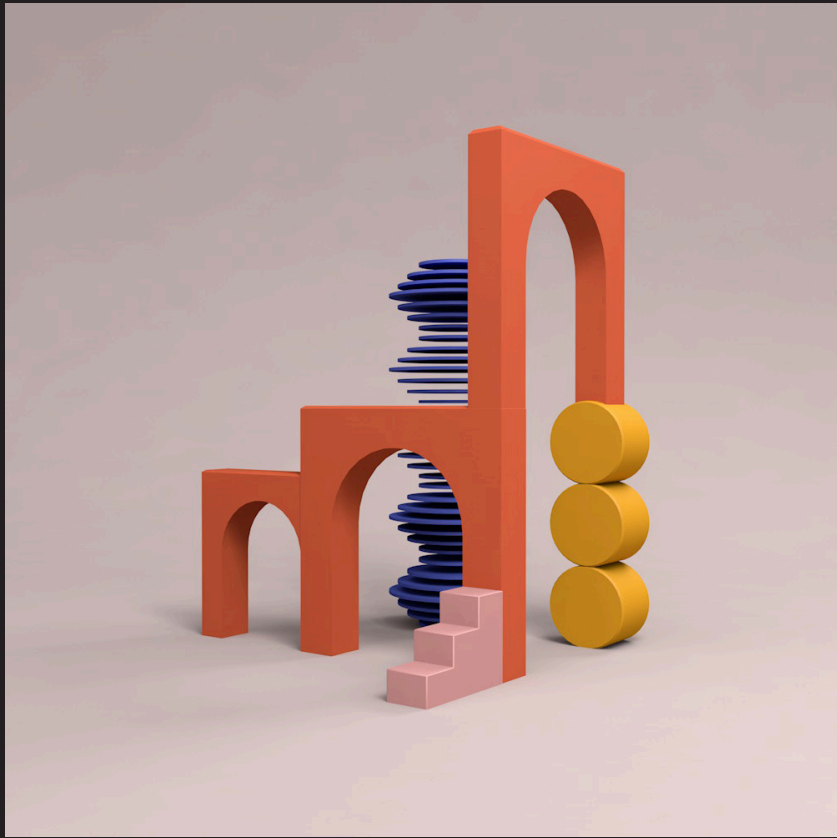
